PD Kristina Kadlec, PhD is a free researcher working at the Dairy Herd Consulting and Research Company (MBFG) in Wunstorf, Germany. She is a specialised veterinarian in microbiology. Her habilitation had the topic „Novel and unusual antimicrobial resistance genes in staphylococci, their occurrence and their mobility“ and her PhD project dealt with antimicrobial resistance in *Bordetella bronchiseptica*. She has been working in this field for 18 years including about 14 in the research group “Molecular Microbiology and Antimicrobial Resistance” at the Institute of Farm Animal Genetics of the Friedrich-Loeffler-Institut (= Federal Research Institute for Animal Health). Her main expertise is the analysis of the genetic basis of antimicrobial resistance and the mobility of resistance genes as well as determining and monitoring phenotypic resistance and the typing of bacteria. She has (co-)authored more than 300 conference presentations and more than 100 papers and acts as reviewer of several international journals. Her enthusiasm and the high quality of her scientific work has been honoured also by three travel grants, some invitations to international conferences and two prizes for her work.
