Ronette Gehring is Professor and Chair of Veterinary Pharmacotherapeutics and Pharmacy at Utrecht University in the Netherlands. Her research focuses on the use of mathematical models to analyze, interpret and extrapolate clinical pharmacology data to improve the safety and efficacy of veterinary medicines, specifically through increased understanding of intra- and interspecies pharmacokinetic and pharmacodynamic differences. She has (co-) authored more than 100 peer-reviewed scientific publications and contributed book chapters to several veterinary textbooks. She has the vice-chair of the Veterinary Medicines Expert Information Committee of the United States Pharmacopoeia and is a diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Clinical Pharmacology (ACVCP) and the European College of Veterinary Pharmacology and Toxicology (ECVPT). She is currently serving as Junior Vice President (European Affairs) of the European Association for Veterinary Pharmacology and Therapeutics.
